## **UK and European Regulatory Trends Update with Schulte's Financial Regulatory and Fund Lawyers**

As the hedge fund regulatory landscape evolves, U.K. regulators' areas of scrutiny are in many cases similar to those of U.S. regulators, though with some differences of emphasis, detail and *modus operandi*.
