Schulte Roth & Zabel Hosts Seminar: Shareholder Activism in Europe

Schulte Roth & Zabel (SRZ) is hosting a seminar on Shareholder Activism in Europe today in London. Convening major industry players, the conference covers the current state of market practice in the United Kingdom and continental Europe. The event is by invitation only.

"Funds and managers are more willing to engage in new types of activism and to consider investing in different jurisdictions. As such, we are seeing more enthusiasm about European markets," commented Mr. Klein. "Supportive corporate governance rules and shareholder rights have made the United Kingdom a natural starting point in Europe for many managers," added Mr. McNally.

"We are pleased to present today's programme, featuring leading dealmakers in the European market. They will share their experiences from recent campaigns and provide perspective on key issues," commented Alan S. Waldenberg, chair of SRZ's Executive Committee.
